

- · ¼ cup crispy cereal of choice


Directions:



LARUE COUNTY FAIR POULTRY

BROILER PEN OF THREE SUB-SECTION RULES

All exhibitors will purchase broilers through the 4-H Poultry Superintendent through the Larue County 4-H Poultry Leader, John Ray Ball. Chicks will be ordered from the same hatchery, and exhibitors must place their orders through the LaRue County Extension Office. Chicks must be prepaid for at time of placing the order.

Minimum of chicks to order is 10. Maximum is 25. All exhibitors must be validated at time of placing chick orders. Name, address, phone# organization, county.

All broiler chicks must be ordered by Monday May 15th 2023. Cost of chicks is approximate.

Cost of chicks shouldn't exceed \$3.00ea. subject to change.

Chicks will be banded with special tamper proof bands with numbering. All numbers will be recorded under each exhibitor's name. Any bird without that band may not be shown. Any band showing signs of tampering or missing will be disqualified.

A pen of three broilers will consist of 3 broilers of the same sex, either all pullets or all cockerels. Broilers will be all Cornish Cross birds, no exceptions.

Exhibitors must abide by all Larue County Fair Rules and Regulations and all State Regulations involving the showing of poultry in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Birds must be at the designated show site by 9a.m. on Saturday July 29th.

All birds must have health papers.

Birds must be in good health. Any bird showing signs of sickness or physical disabilities, injuries or parasites will be sorted out and will not be eligible for the show even if they have health papers. Poultry Superintendent has the final say.

If a bird in the pen of three is disqualified for any reason, the exhibitor may offer up another of there birds as a replacement. The same ownership rules apply to the replacement.

All birds must be in possession of the exhibitor at least 5 weeks before the show.

Only one pen of three per exhibitor.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have fresh water and feed for there birds while at the show.

Birds will be placed in order of 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} etc.. Premiums will be given to the top 3 places and ribbons will be given to the top 10 pens.

Exhibitors are responsible for removing birds from the site once the judging is over and prizes have been awarded.

If an exhibitor needs assistance after the show processing the show broiler birds please let us know at the time the chicks are ordered.

This is a new class of poultry for LaRue and surrounding Counties and we are still in the learning curve. Please be patient with us and we can all learn together. All rules are subject to change without notice by Poultry Superintendent.
