- 5) Facility space is limited, so reservation forms will be dated when forms and payment are received. We may not be able to accommodate all requests for space.
- Expo Hours; Saturday, March 16 2024, 10:00 AM 2:00 PM; Set up 8:00 AM-10:00AM
- Booth space is relatively small, one six foot table and two chairs will be provided. Late registered participants may be required to provide their own tables and chairs.
- 8) Advertising/ Product Display shall be limited to your booth space.
- 9) Booth areas shall be kept clean and safe, contact Extension Office if there is a question about an item.
- 10) Concessions will be provided by the LaRue County Beef or Pork Associations; no sales shall conflict directly with their products (sandwiches and drinks).
