SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Competition in the open and junior show is open to bantams, ducks and large fowl AND MEAT BIRDS.
2. LARUE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS AND LARUE EXTENSION will not be responsible for losses, accidents, or damages beyond its control, but all reasonable care will be taken.
3. The show room will open at 8:00 a.m. EST.
4. BRING YOUR OWN CAGE.
5. No one is allowed in area of Judging except the show clerks or show officials.
6. No sick birds will be allowed in the show area. Owners will be asked to remove them.
7. ABA and APA standards will govern the classes. Protest will be handled by Show Chairman.
8. Handle your own birds unless permission of the owner is given.
9. The LaRue County Show Chairman reserves the right to add or substitute judges if necessary. The Judge's decision is final AND RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.
10. No Alcohol is allowed in area.
11. **ANY KY BIRDS WITHOUT CURRENT CERTIFICATE WILL BE TESTED ON SITE. KY DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE WILL BE PRESENT DURING SHOW. Larue county fairgrounds is not responsible for any damage birds due to testing.**
