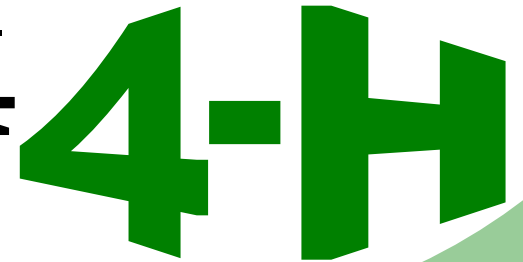

To be eligible for awards, 4-H members must earn points in a minimum of three different areas and submit completed Record Form to the Extension Office by September 30th.

Junior level includes ages 9-13, Senior level includes ages 14-18. The Junior and Senior 4-Her with the most points will be presented with the Outstanding Junior & Senior 4-H Member Awards, unless that individual has previously won that award. Members who previously won may work to earn the bronze, silver and gold Outstanding 4-H Member Award Levels. Cloverbuds are eligible to complete the Cloverbud Awards Point System Form.
